Aileen McB provided a verbal report on the work being undertaken by the above part time post. Lots of referrals from Social Workers at the Detox Team and appropriate links have been made with a variety of Older People organisations. 8. Community Safety

Sharon F provided verbal report on work of DAMAS and 3 Joint Action groups within the Community Safety Partnership. Discussion ensued about how we ensure that work undertaken within these groups link with strategic priorities from older strategies e.g. Integrated Children's Service Plan.

Aileen McB raised the issue of Arrest Referral Service, which will cost £11903 to continue until March 2007. East Ayrshire JPIG has already agreed to support continuation of funding for this service and after discussion South Ayrshire JPIG also agreed to support this.
